Starting in 1937, this family-vineyard is located East of the Bordeaux wine region, 25 minutes from Saint-Emilion. Wines of the Franc de Ferriere family originate from a unique area on the hills of the Dordogne river, giving the appellation all of its originality and grace.

WINEMAKING

Made from selected plots on the property, the grapes are fermented and worked to produce a smooth yet robust structure. Once the fermentation is complete, the wine ages for 12 months in French oak barrels. This aging allows the exchange of oxygen with the wine to smoothen the tannins and provide great structure.

TASTING NOTES

An elegant garnet colour. The nose is a combination of red fruit, highlighted by fresh spices and clove.

This is a very elegant wine, with smooth tannins and length underlined by blackcurrant on the palate.
